

Shanghai Science Debate Competition

Code of Conduct

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to help maintain a pleasant, safe and healthy environment for all participants. It is very important that all the participants have a common understanding of the standards of behaviour expected of them in order to maintain a safe and enjoyable event for everyone involved.

1. All participants must agree to abide by this Code of Conduct

(a) Before the start of each Competition, all participants shall sign the undertaking at the conclusion of this Code of Conduct that they will abide by this Code of Conduct for the duration of the Competition.

(b) At least one parent or guardian of every debater attending the Competition shall also sign the undertaking.

2. What participants must do:

(a) Abide by all rules, guidelines, and restrictions set by the Shanghai Science Debate Competition organizing committee to ensure fairness, safety, and smooth operation of the event.

(b) Behave in a respectful and courteous manner toward all participants, judges, guests, event staff, and audience members. This includes shaking hands with opponents at the conclusion of each debate round.

(c) Be punctual for all rounds, briefings, and ceremonies. Participants must arrive at designated venues 15 minutes prior to scheduled start times and remain present until formally dismissed.

(d) Refrain from using AI tools or external assistance during debate delivery. All arguments, rebuttals, and materials must reflect the participants' original thought and research.

(d) Accept judge's rulings respectfully. Disputes must follow official channels.

(g) Dress appropriately in formal or semi-formal attire as specified by the competition guidelines.

(h) Actively listen to opponents, judges, and moderators. Participants must not interrupt others during speeches, cross-examinations, or feedback sessions.

(i) Report safety concerns or violations immediately to event organizers. Participants are responsible for helping maintain a safe, inclusive, and harassment-free environment.

3. What happens if a participant breaches the Code of Conduct?

(a) Breaches can be reported to a Complaints Officer. If a participant believes that another participant has breached this Code of Conduct, s/he may report the breach to the Complaints Officer(Ryan Xu, ryan@lozo.live).

“As the participant of the Shanghai Science Debate Competition, I pledge to uphold the highest standards of humility, integrity, respect and leadership in pursuit of excellence.”

HUMILITY: A participant acknowledges that growth stems from learning, not just victory. They celebrate opponents' ideas, take judges' rulings respectfully, and shake hands after every round to honor the collective effort of debate.

INTEGRITY: A participant competes with honesty, submitting only original arguments and evidence. They arrive punctually, maintain confidentiality of case materials, and prioritize safety by reporting violations to organizers.

诚信：我将恪守学术诚信，所有论点与论据均为原创，杜绝抄袭。守时参赛，保护赛事材料机密性，并主动向组委会举报任何违规行为。

RESPECT: A participant engages in civil discourse, listening actively without interruption. They avoid personal attacks, offensive language, or disruptive behavior, fostering a welcoming environment for all.

尊重：我将以文明交流为准则，耐心倾听，避免人身攻击或不当言论。共同维护安全、包容的竞赛环境，尊重评委、对手、工作人员及观众。

LEADERSHIP: A participant models professionalism through attire, preparation, and composure. They inspire peers by accepting feedback constructively and upholding the competition's values even in defeat.

领导力： 我将以身作则，着装得体，准备充分，沉着应对胜负。以辩论素养激励同伴，虚心接受反馈，展现大赛倡导的价值观与责任感。
